Notice is hereby given that the Hortonville Village Board will hold a Public Hearing on Thursday, November 16, 2017, in the Community Center at 531 North Nash Street, Hortonville, Wisconsin at 6:30 p.m. or as soon thereafter as possible. The formal public hearing is to consider a zoning amendment establishing a Downtown Zoning District.

The amendment creates section 17.30 Downtown District to foster development that promotes orderly development and redevelopment, recognizes the downtown as a unique and historic space, promotes mixed land uses that create thriving economic development and community gatherings, and recognizes walkability as an important feature.

Any interested person may address the Village Board by letter or appear in person or by agent and be heard.

The proposed zoning amendment may be viewed Monday-Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. at the Administration Office in the Municipal Services Center at 531 N. Nash St. Copies of the information may be obtained for a fee either in person or by calling the office at 920-779-6011.
