DASH Harvesting of Invasive Plants BLACK OTTER LAKE, OUTAGAMIE COUNTY

Black Otter Lake District

The Black Otter Lake District is soliciting services for Diver Assisted Suction Harvesting (DASH) to manage Eurasian water milfoil (HWM) and any other invasive species on Black Otter Lake located in Outagamie County, Wisconsin. DASH is a mechanical process and requires a mechanical harvesting permit (Form 3200-113 (R 10/16)) from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR). The purpose of this project is to provide Suction Harvesting (DASH – diver assisted suction harvesting) of Black Otter Lake. The winning bid will be awarded to the responsible bidder who guarantees the best value and the greatest number of surface acres to be treated through DASH, for a sum not to exceed of \$20,000.00. Qualifications and Proposals will be received by the Village of Hortonville on behalf of the Black Otter Lake District, 531 N. Nash St., Hortonville, WI 54944 until 12:00 p.m. Central Time, March 16, 2018.
