9.04 BURNING RESTRICTED. (1) OUTDOOR BURNING RESTRICTED. No person, firm, corporation, or organization shall initiate any outdoor fire within the Village limits. The following exceptions shall apply, however, no materials shall be burned upon any street, curb, gutter, or sidewalk:

- (a) Outdoor cooking over a fire contained in a device or structure designed for such use.
- (b) Controlled burning of grass or similar vegetation for environmental management purposes, with prior written approval from the Fire Chief.
- (c) Ceremonial campfires, bonfires, or brush piles, with prior written approval from the Fire Chief.
- (d) Controlled burning of dry leaves and other non-offensive dry yard debris, and small campfires, provided however, that such burning is:
 - 1. Responsibly monitored until the fire is extinguished.
 - 2. Conducted at times when excessive weather conditions will not cause a public nuisance or result in danger to public health or safety.
 - 3. Located at least thirty (30) feet from any neighboring structure.
 - 4. Burning, other than campfires, shall only be conducted between the hours of 7:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M. Monday through Sunday. (Revised 9/01/05)
- (e) Other occasions of desirable outdoor burning, but not including burning of refuse or recyclables, with prior written approval of the Fire Chief.
